- RIGHT TO LIFE, LIBERTY AND PERSONAL SECURITY
- RIGHT TO PHYSICAL INTEGRITY
- RIGHT TO THE HIGHEST ATTAINABLE STANDARD OF PHYSICAL AND MENTAL HEALTH
- RIGHT TO INFORMATION
- RIGHT TO AN ADEQUATE STANDARD OF LIVING, INCLUDING FOOD, WATER AND HOUSING
- RIGHT TO PARTICIPATION
- RIGHT TO AN EFFECTIVE REMEDY
- RIGHT TO A SAFE, CLEAN AND HEALTHY ENVIRONMENT
