



IPEN DONATION POLICY

This donation policy is a steering document based on IPEN's values and mission. IPEN's work relies on contributions from individuals and organizations who support the movement toward a toxics-free future. We greatly appreciate our donors and pledge to continue pursuing this work to bring about healthier futures for all.

In this policy we express our overall values for working with donors and how we approach funder relationships.

Principles:

- IPEN accepts donations from private donors, foundations, governments, socially responsible businesses, and other institutions and organizations that align with IPEN's goals.
- IPEN accepts donations for specific purposes and for general support.
- IPEN may acknowledge donations publicly with the consent of the donor. IPEN will honor any requests for anonymity.
- IPEN commits to clear, accurate, and timely communications with donors.
- IPEN commits to our best effort in fulfilling any agreed-upon conditions of donations and to work with the donor in a timely manner when circumstances require adjusting such conditions.
- IPEN provides our public financial documents and other financial information to donors when needed, upon request.

Evaluating New Funder Relationships:

IPEN welcomes support from new funders who value our work and find convergence with our values and mission. IPEN's work involves banning the manufacture and use of toxic chemicals that threaten public health and the environment. IPEN also represents civil society in policy deliberations that may involve government officials who are also political candidates. Thus, IPEN:

- Does not take donations from chemical companies and/or other companies whose operations threaten public health and/or the environment.
- Does not take donations from or contribute to candidates for political office or political parties; IPEN does not engage in electioneering, nor takes positions on candidates for office.
- Does not take donations from individuals, corporations, or other entities involved in or suspected of unethical, corrupt, or illegal activities.
- Does not make endorsements or adopt policy positions as a condition of any donation.

IPEN commits to conducting due diligence around new donor relationships and pledges to reject or return any donations that are found in breach of this policy or are otherwise found to be unsuitable.
